The HandReach Children's Healing Initiative develops resources in medical and rehabilitative care for child trauma survivors in the developing world. We work at the acute, reconstructive, and psychosocial levels to help children debilitated by severe burns and amputations return to full function and a productive future.

At the heart of HandReach's mission lies a commitment to transforming institutions through developing the expertise of the people who make up those institutions. To fulfill this mission, HandReach is focusing on three areas of interest:

Reconstructive Surgical Clinics.
Psychosocial Rehabilitation Camps/Conferences.
Co-op Programs, through partner universities.

We advocate to promote greater access to integrated rehabilitative care, and a place in society for trauma survivors that includes greater access and acceptance for people with physical differences.
